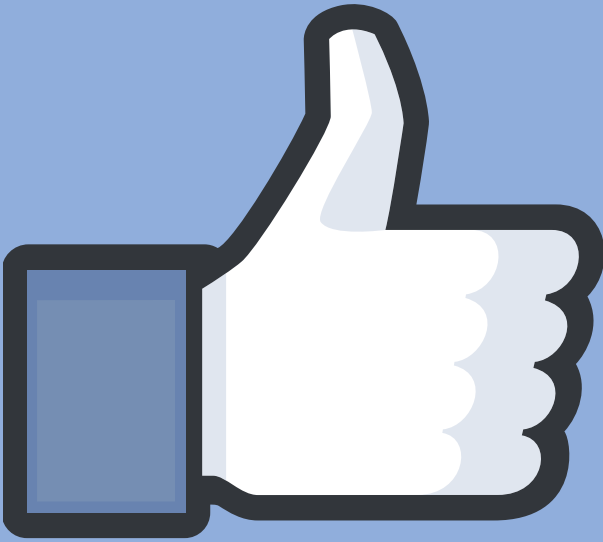

#### TIME QUESTIONS

Measure how close you get to the magic 35mins.



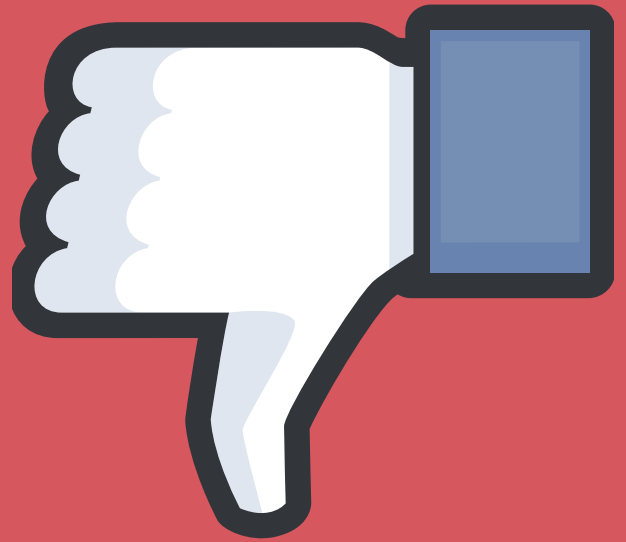
#### SUMMARISE STEPS

Help yourself remember your problem solving techniques.



#### TEACH OTHERS

Nothing challenges understanding more than teaching someone else.



#### FEAR MISTAKES

Questions you get wrong will teach you more than the questions you get right.



#### ONLY USE PENCIL

Colour is your friend, use it to highlight important problem solving techniques.



#### FORGET DRAWINGS

Questions completed in the past will help solve the question you're doing now.



#### MAKE EXCUSES

If you don't have equipment with you, sketch it instead.



#### ONE METHOD

More than one method for everything, experiment.
